First-Year Graduate Curriculum Best Practices

- Homework and quiz deadlines coordinated between first-year instructors and presented at the beginning of the semester, so that homework due dates are not overlapping and quizzes are on separate weeks.
- 2. Homework assigned at least 6 days ahead of the due date and solutions distributed to teaching assistant simultaneously.
- 3. Two regular office hours, with instructor and/or teaching assistant, at least 24 hours in advance of homeworks and quizzes and 24 hours after assignment.
- 4. Graded assessments returned at most 10 days after due date along with solutions.
- Maintain course information, including assignments, solutions, grades, and other announcements on Canvas.
- 6. Mid semester grades distributed to students progress report to see if student will pass with better than C.
- Any substitute instructors needed for planned travel should be selected following Institute and School policies.
